A guide on how our events are Covid Secure for schools

The creation of all our events follows all the current government guidance, working safely during coronavirus (2021 update) found HERE and Actions for schools during the coronavirus outbreak (2021 update) found HERE.



This guide is to help you understand the precautions we're taking. We go into more details in our risk assessment, which you can request to see and which will be emailed to you if you book with us. The overall objective for us is to reduce transmission of Covid-19 through thorough cleaning and the maintaining of social distancing where possible.

How we'll interact with your school

We'll visit individual groups over a day, or up to three days for large schools, in a suitable space in your school, either in their classrooms or the hall, so that your bubble systems can be maintained.

Our company members will arrive at your school ready to perform and, if needed, wearing a face mask. All of our team are familiar on how to wear and remove masks safely. Company members carry hand sanitiser and anti-bacterial wipes with them and are familiar with the correct way to use these. They'll use them at specific times throughout the day, such as on arrival and departure.

Company Members are familiar with proper distancing and will only start their interaction with the class once they are satisfied that the children are at the appropriate required distance for the event to begin.

We aim to be flexible and will make sure the event can fit within your own school's policy.

What we're asking your school to do

We ask that your staff and students maintain the appropriate distance from our company member throughout their visit. We'll remind children as part of the event too.

We're following the NHS test and trace protocols. If you have any cases in your school within 21 days of our visit please contact us to let us know.

How we'll reduce risk of transmissions between schools

Company members are following correct social distancing measures not just throughout their visit with you, but in day to day life and we're monitoring everyone's wellbeing and health, checking each morning that everyone remains symptom free and has had no communication from NHS track and trace.

How our work was made:

From conception, throughout design and rehearsals we have the safety of our team and audience at the forefront of what we have created.

During rehearsals company members remained distanced when required to, and have designated areas to rest in. We worked in well ventilated spaces and outdoors whenever possible. Each day we check in with the team that everyone remains symptom free.

Routine hand cleaning is worked into the day as well as one way systems and additional cleaning. Each company member has their own set of props and costumes.
