We are an ITC Ethical Employer and our 2021/22 base rate for performers is £498.94 per week + touring allowances and accommodation, where applicable. In addition, performers who have previous professional experience of relevance to Theatre Alibi receive a sliding scale of financial supplements.

Auditions will take place at our base in Exeter in the week beginning 23<sup>rd</sup> August. All travel expenses will be reimbursed.
